CONCLUSION

5.1. Conclusion

The result of the study above there are two parts of the data analysis from the interview that the writer did. The first are about the reason why male dancers choose their profession as a dancers. The second one is a discrimination which is experienced by male dancers. They have different answers about why they choose their profession as a male dancer. There are six reasons why they choose to become dancers. First is their passion. The second is to express their feelings. Next is that they followed their parent's advice. The fourth is for the sake of achievement. Then, dancing is cool, and the last is hobby. Dancing becomes a part of their lives, and bring them to find their way to their career. When they start to choose to dance, every of them also has different feeling when they decided to choose to become dancers. Happy, proud, more honorable, even unconfident are what they feel when they choose to become dancers. Even, some of them start their profession with trying, but, at the end it has become their passion. This kinds of passion, actually bring themselves into the bigger step.

The second result is about the discrimination which is experienced by male dancers. The discrimination which is experienced by male dancers was various but the discrimination has more direct in bullying. As the result of the interview, the writer found that the male dancers were said

like being a sissy, getting verbal and physical bullying. The idea about why male choose to become a dancer is mocked. They are mocked because some choreography should be done by a girl. They are mocked because of their costumes, and they are underestimated as dancing athlete. Most people still assume that dancing does not belong to male profession, but it belongs to female. However, the discrimination they had experienced do not stop them to continue their career in dancing. They have their own statements to continue their career in dancing: keep seeing it as a passion, ignore about what people said, give people some explanation about what Ballroom dancing is, keep going on their life, only care with the achievement which they did not achieve yet, and the most important is they do not care about what other people said about themselves. People only judge because they understand nothing about their profession as a dancer.

Moreover, it can be concluded that nowadays, dancing does not only belong to female's profession, but also male can stand on it. Discrimination about sissy image in the male dancers were stated by people who do not really understand about dancing.

5.2. Suggestion

The result of the study is expected to provide a discrimination which is experienced by male dancers especially in Ballroom Dance that happened for long time ago and still happen until nowadays to the male dancers because people often assume that dancing career belongs to

female. The writer hopes that the explanation that the writer gives in this thesis can be used to give people an understanding about what Ballroom dancing is and hopefully the discrimination to the male dancer will not happen again in the future because not all male dancers are gay, even they do the dancing moves beautifully. They are not sissy.
