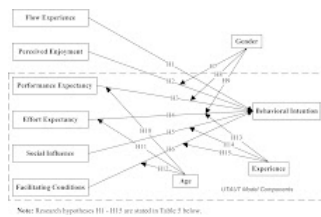


Figure 1. Theoretical model.tif

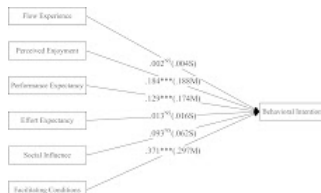


Figure 2. Analysis of causal effects in the theoretical model.tif

Second, on pages 9-12, standard statistical measures/terms should be italicised for APA compliance: covers *t*-tests, *p*(significance level) and *R*² (R-squared [I can't superscript the squared in email], in the text as well as in table headings).

Dear Editor-in-Chief, International Journal of Games and Computer-Mediated Simulations, Brock R. Dubbels, PhD.,

With full respect I am astonished and disappointed at your advice that the AE has rejected my article. All previous comments from the reviewers and the AE were very positive and I believe that I addressed all of the comments and suggestions made by the reviewers and especially the AE in the revised document which I have attached again with this email.

I wish to explain the three new comments on my article that seems to be causing this problem.

1. "explaining the overall demographics of their participants."

This change was not asked for in the AE review comments because it has always been addressed in the article. Please see the section headed Analysis of descriptive data on page 8 of the article.

2. "discussion of culture and how their findings may or not be generalized."

This comment was not part of the AE comments for correction and so it was not addressed. There is a general reference to this at the end of the article in the last section. The study did not include any variables designed to measure cultural affects and so other than general comments this issue about culture was not analyzed or discussed in detail.

3. "why their sample size was so small".

This comment was also not part of the comments by the AE for correction. The final sample size is 895 which exceeds the minimum sample size of 400 required for a level of confidence of 95 percent with 5 percent precision.

In light of my comments above I ask that you please reconsider the decision to reject this article as I am very concerned that these late comments from the AE which I have explained above have reversed comments which praised the article (please see <http://www.igi-global.com/submission/comments/?projectid=a676087d-4906-49d6-bf16-bea234acdf04>).

I am of course prepared to make any changes with regard to these three issues after the AE has considered my responses above.
