ABSTRACT

A novel entitled *A Bend in the Road* by Nicholas Sparks tells about a life of a deputy sheriff in North Carolina town, Miles Ryan, after the death of his wife, Missy, in a hit and run accident. In two years he tried to reveal who is the murderer of his belated wife. On his effort to reveal that case, he meets his son's teacher Sarah Andrews who finally become his lover. In the middle of their relationship, Brian who is Sarah's brother confesses to her that he is the murderer of Miles's wife. Miles gets angry about Brian's confession and ends his relationship with Sarah because he thinks that Sarah has planned to hide the truth about Brian from him. But finally, Miles decides to forgive Brian and starts his relationship again with Sarah.

This research aims to find out Miles Ryan's changing attitude in his effort to reveal the death of his wife that happened two years ago. Two theories will be used to analyze Miles Ryan's character.

First, the writer uses Sigmund Freud's psychoanalytic approach about three elements of personality, id, ego and superego. Changing attitude nearly always becomes the process to reach the result of these three elements. So the writer hopes Sigmund Freud's Psychoanalytic theory will help to find the ground theory to be applied on the character of Miles Ryan. After Miles' id, ego and superego are clearly traced, it is easier to discover the motivation behind the changing attitude of Miles Ryan through the murderer of his wife using the Theory of Needs by Abraham Maslow.

The changing attitude first happens when Miles Ryan met Sarah Andrews who is his lover and suddenly forgets about his effort to reveal his wife's death. The second changing attitude happens when Miles knew that the death of his wife is caused by Brian who is his lover's brother and also the murderer of his belated wife, but instead of being angry he forgives Brian about the case that happened two years ago.

ABSTRAK

Novel berjudul *A Bend in the Road* yang ditulis oleh Nicholas Sparks menceritakan tentang kehidupan seorang deputi sherif di kota Carolina utara, bernama Miles Ryan setelah kematian istrinya, Missy dalam kecelakaan tabrak lari. Selama dua tahun dia telah mencoba mengungkap pembunuh mendiang istrinya. Dalam usahanya untuk mengungkap kasus itu, dia bertemu dengan guru anak lelakinya bernama Sarah Andrews yang pada akhirnya menjadi kekasihnya. Di tengah hubungan mereka, Brian adik laki-laki Sarah mengaku padanya jika dia adalah pembunuh istri Miles. Miles menjadi marah tentang pengakuan Brian dan mengakhiri hubungannya dengan Sarah karena dia berfikir jika Sarah berkomplot untuk menyembunyikan kebenaran darinya dengan Brian. Tetapi pada akhirnya, Miles memutuskan untuk memaafkan Brian dan memulai kembali hubungannya dengan Sarah.

Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk menemukan perubahan sikap Miles Ryan dalam usahanya mengungkap kematian istrinya yang terjadi dua tahun lalu. Dua teori akan dipergunakan dalam menganalisa karakter dari Miles Ryan.

Pertama-tama, penulis menggunakan teori dari Sigmund Freud tentang teori psikoanalisis yang berisi tiga elemen dasar dari kepribadian, id, ego dan superego. Perubahan sikap seringkali menjadi proses untuk mencapai hasil dari tiga elemen tersebut. Maka, penulis berharap teori psikoanalisis dari Sigmund Freud dapat membantu dalam menemukan teori dasar yang dapat digunakan pada karakter Miles Ryan.

Selanjutnya, setelah id, ego dan superego dari Miles tampak jelas, ini akan mempermudah pencarian motivasi dibalik perubahan sikap dari Miles Ryan terhadap pembunuh istrinya menggunakan teori dasar kebutuhan milik Abraham Maslow.

Perubahan sikap pertama kali yang terjadi ketika Miles Ryan bertemu dengan kekasihnya Sarah Andrews dan tiba-tiba melupakan usahanya untuk mengungkap kematian istrinya. Perubahan sikap yang kedua terjadi ketika Miles telah mengetahui kematian istrinya disebabkan oleh Brian yang mana merupakan adik laki-laki kekasihnya dan juga pembunuh almarhum istrinya, kemudian ia memaafkan Brian mengenai segala persoalan yang telah terjadi dua tahun lalu.
