CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Linguistics Deviations consists of nine parts. They are discoursal deviation, semantic deviation, lexical deviation, grammatical deviation, morphological deviation, phonological and graphological deviation, and external and internal deviation. Linguistics deviations happens because people break the rules of the language whether they realize it or not. In this research, the writer analyzed the effect of the using of linguistics deviation in comic or manga. The writer used Fujio's Doraemon as the subject to be analyzed.

According to the analysis and interpretation in Chapter IV, the writer found there are seven kinds of linguistics deviations. They are discoursal deviation, semantic deviation, morphological deviation, lexical deviation, grammatical deviation, and phonological and graphological deviation which is deviations that are found in each episode is different. The writer concluded that graphological deviation is used the most often compare than other linguistic deviations in Fujio's Doraemon.

Comic or *manga* comprises both illustration and texts. The texts of comic or *manga* are made as though the readers can hear the sound of the speakers. By using of Stylistics analysis in comic or *manga*, the writer can interpret the effects of the use of

5.2 Suggestion
