CHAPTER V.

CONCLUSION

From the analysis, there are several points that can be concluded. Those points are answering the problem formulation of this thesis. There are three big points as a conclusion:

A. Archetype

1. Persona

Hillary's persona shows her mask when she face the public, she hides the problem which happens to her from other people.

3. Shadow
