## **CHAPTER V**

## CONCLUSION

In this thesis the writer focused on Michael Jackson's biography and actions in trying to fulfill Popular Culture's criteria. The writer chose this for her thesis because it is interesting to see how popular culture has influenced the life of a pop star like Michael Jackson. Because of this, popular culture approach was used to analyze Michael Jackson and his society.

Michael Jackson was born to be a superstar who had many talents. His clear voice, his hair and fashion styles, his trademarks on his moonwalk dance and choreography on stage has supported him to become a popular singer. Based on Popular Culture's criteria, Michael Jackson as an icon becomes an object of Popular Culture by 1) sacrificing his individual wants, 2) supporting whatever has become the belief and value of the people, 3) maintaining the success of commerciality, and 4) creating an imitative aspect for his Popular Culture audiences to follow.

Although through his biography, such as when he had to suffer from his father's treatments that he had to have multiple plastic surgeries, be on a strict diet, cooperate with the recording companies to obtain a lot of money, and marry with Lisa Marie Presley helps the continuation of his popularity; it is seen that actually he did not enjoy himself as a popular culture icon. Yet, he continued to make people happy. This is why, although he is sick or sad, he always tries his best to show off his smile to people.

As a result, people have always waited for Michael Jackson's performances. People have also tried to imitate Michael Jackson's actions such as the moonwalk dance, so they can also feel the success that Michael Jackson achieved.
