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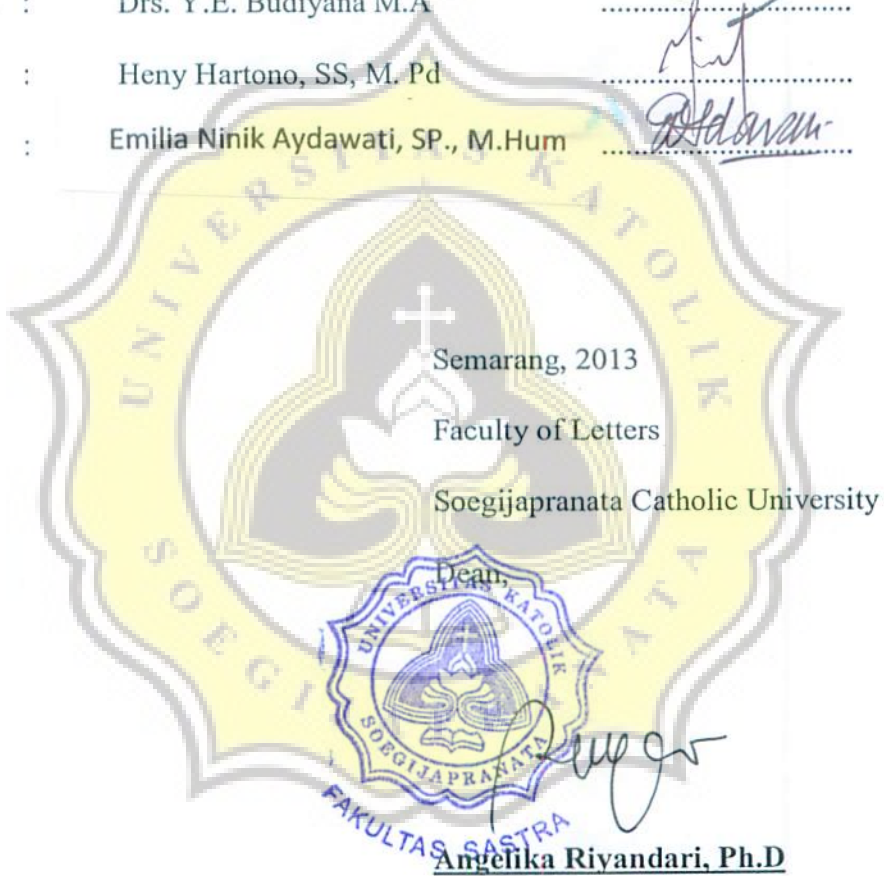
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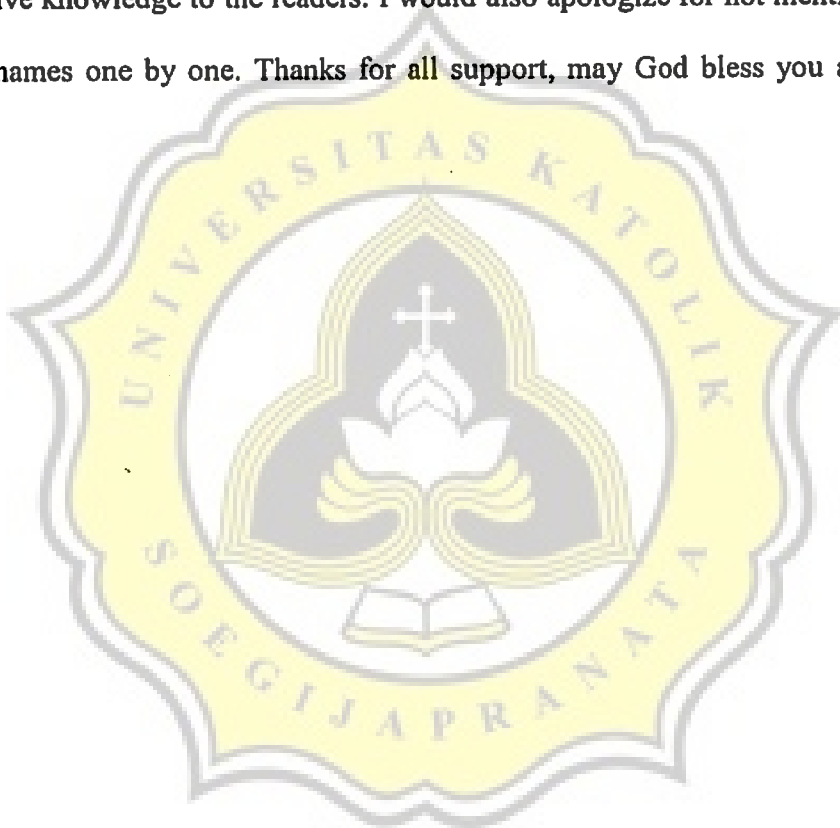


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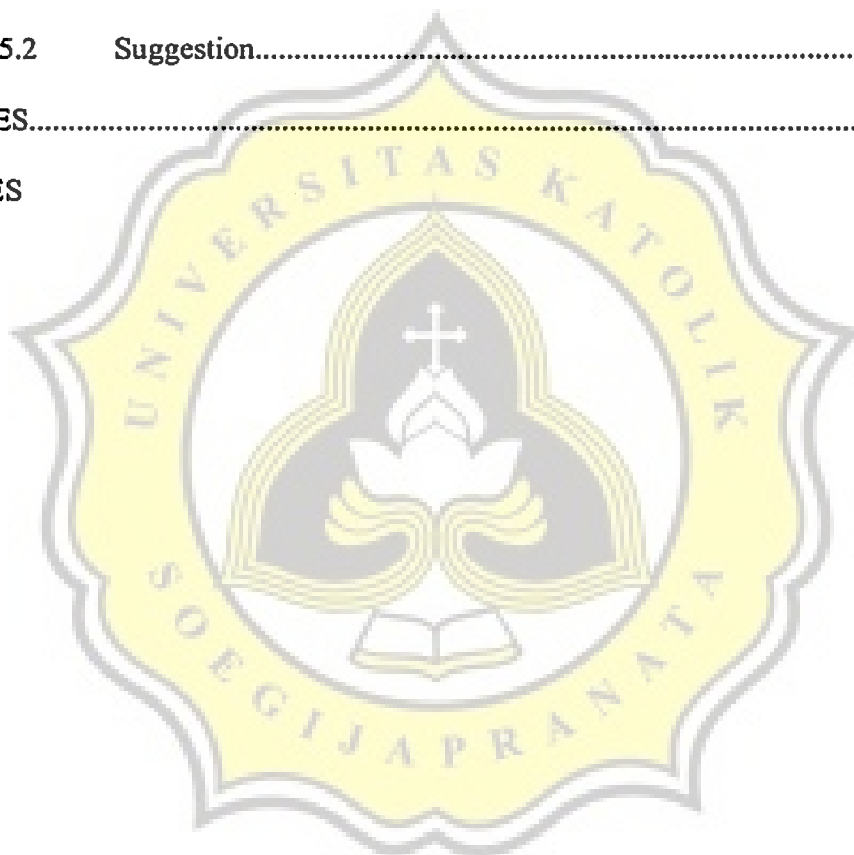
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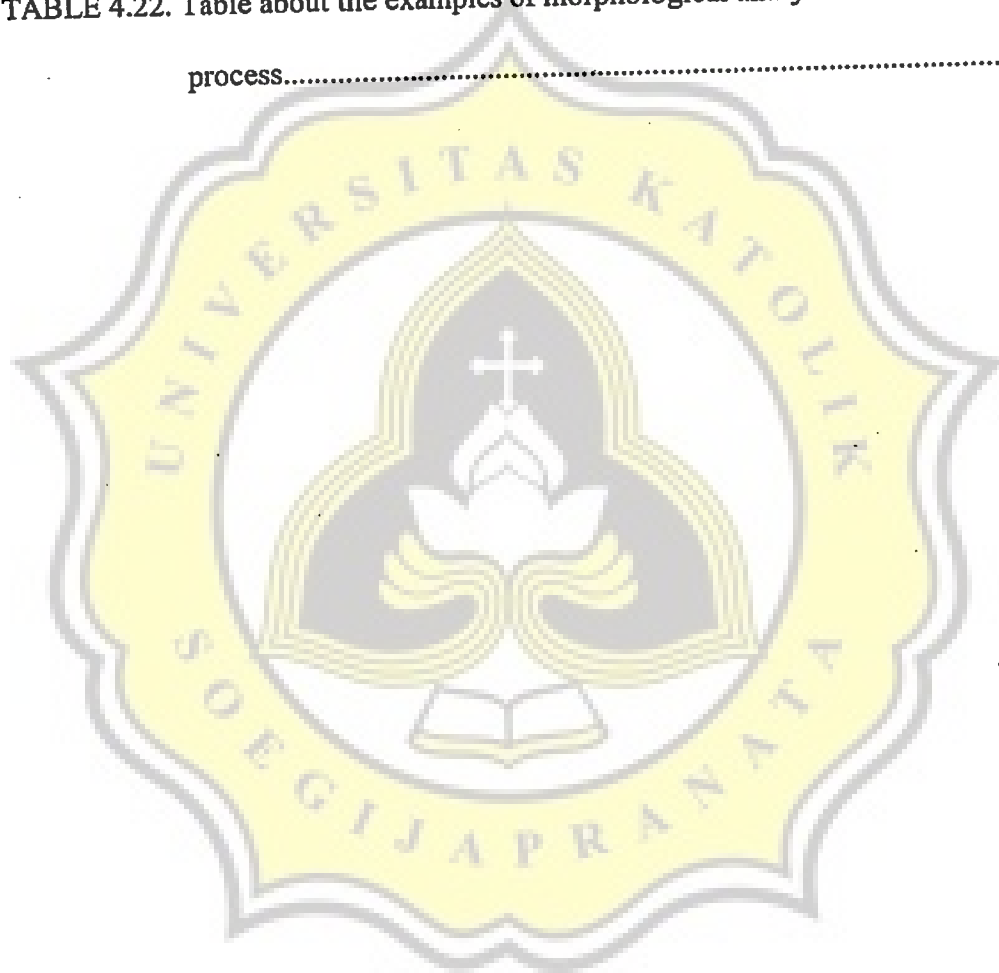
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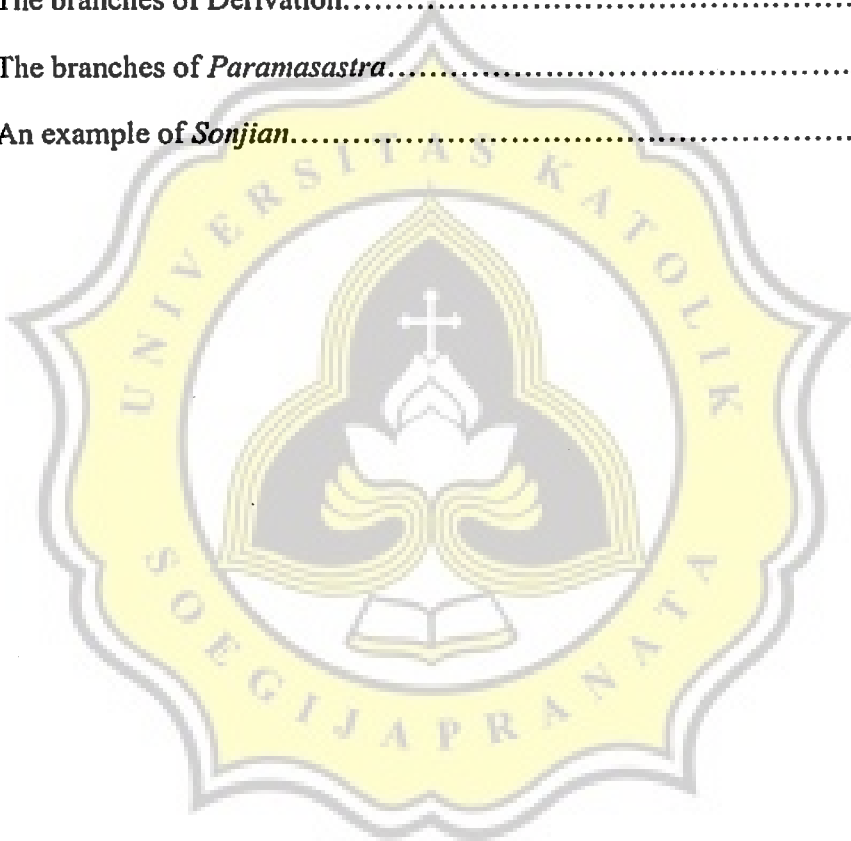
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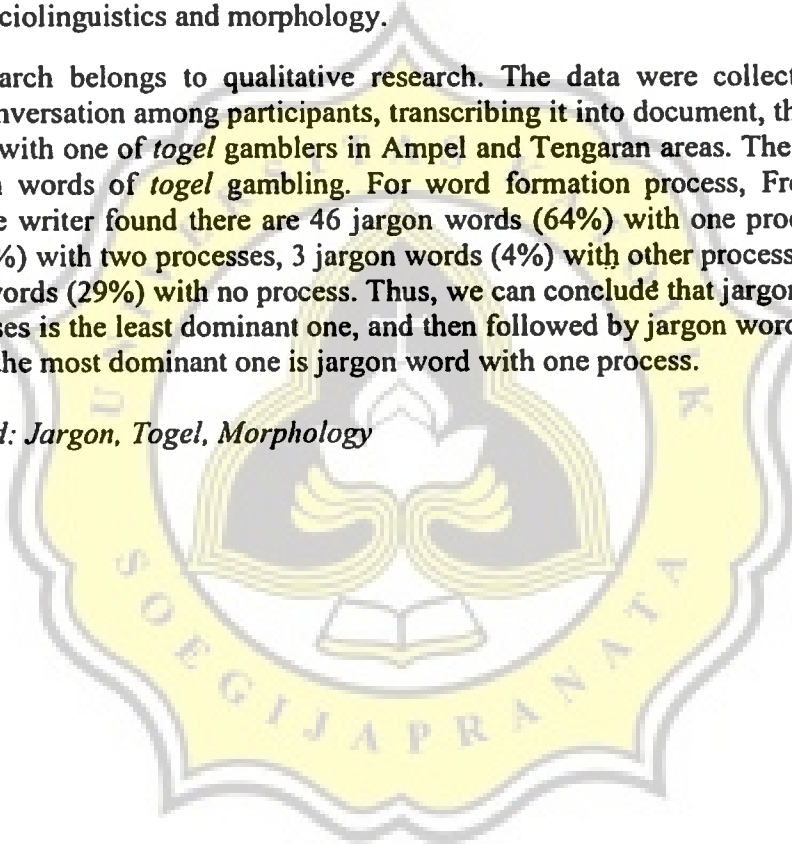


ABSTRACT

Jargon is an occupational and secret language, so it occurs in the occupational fields and only the people who work in the same field can understand it. This research aims to discover the jargons used in *togel* gambling and the morphologically to find out its word formation process of the jargons. So, this research was conducted within the domain of sociolinguistics and morphology.

The research belongs to qualitative research. The data were collected by recording the conversation among participants, transcribing it into document, then the writer validated with one of *togel* gamblers in Ampel and Tenganan areas. The writer found 72 jargon words of *togel* gambling. For word formation process, From 72 jargon words the writer found there are 46 jargon words (64%) with one process, 2 jargon words (3%) with two processes, 3 jargon words (4%) with other processes and then 21 jargon words (29%) with no process. Thus, we can conclude that jargon word with two processes is the least dominant one, and then followed by jargon words with no process, and the most dominant one is jargon word with one process.

ABSTRAK

Jargon adalah bahasa kerja dan rahasia, sehingga terjadi di bidang pekerjaan dan hanya orang-orang yang bekerja di bidang yang sama dapat memahaminya. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menemukan jargon yang digunakan dalam togel judi dan secara morfologis untuk mengetahui proses pembentukan kata. Jadi, penelitian ini termasuk dalam domain sosiolinguistik dan morfologi.

Penelitian ini adalah penelitian kualitatif. Data dikumpulkan dengan merekam percakapan antara peserta, menyalin ke dalam dokumen, maka penulis divalidasi dengan salah satu penjudi togel di Ampel dan daerah Tenganan. Penulis menemukan 72 kata jargon dalam perjudian togel. Untuk proses pembentukan kata, Dari 72 kata jargon penulis menemukan ada 46 kata jargon (64%) dengan satu proses, ada 2 kata jargon (3%) dengan dua proses, ada 3 kata jargon (4%) dengan proses lain dan ada 21 kata jargon (29%) tanpa proses. Dengan demikian, kita dapat menyimpulkan bahwa jargon dengan dua proses yang dominan, dan kemudian diikuti oleh jargon tanpa proses morfologi, dan yang paling dominan adalah kata jargon dengan satu proses.
