CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

In this thesis, the writer focuses in two aspects, those are, Sociological approach and dramatic aspects. Sociological approach is the criticism that analyses a film within the frame of socio-historical condition of the story or the production. The sociological approach interprets cinema as a reflection of the society where it was created. Meanwhile, dramatic aspects, including, the type of film, character, dialogues, and costumes and make up, is used to analyze the main character of the film, Georgiana. The ordinary people show the low status and the Georgiana shows the high class. Meanwhile, Princess Diana decided to divorce after knowing Prince Charles's affairs.

Thus, the social problem between Georgiana and Diana cannot be the same because of the different era lived by each personage.
