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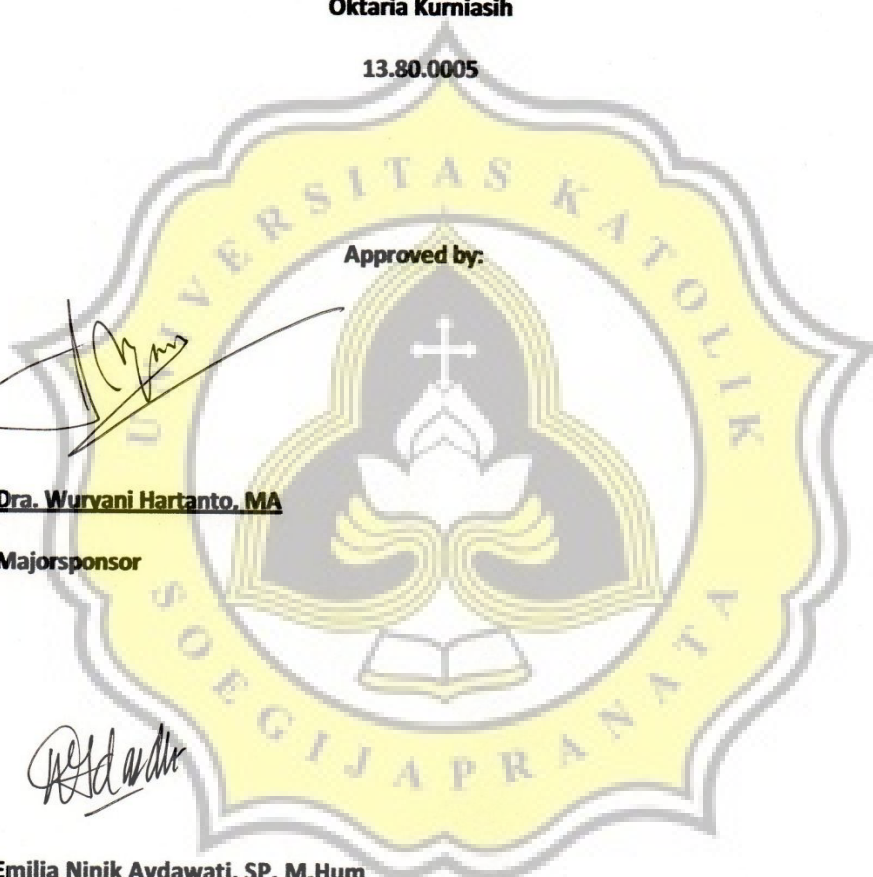



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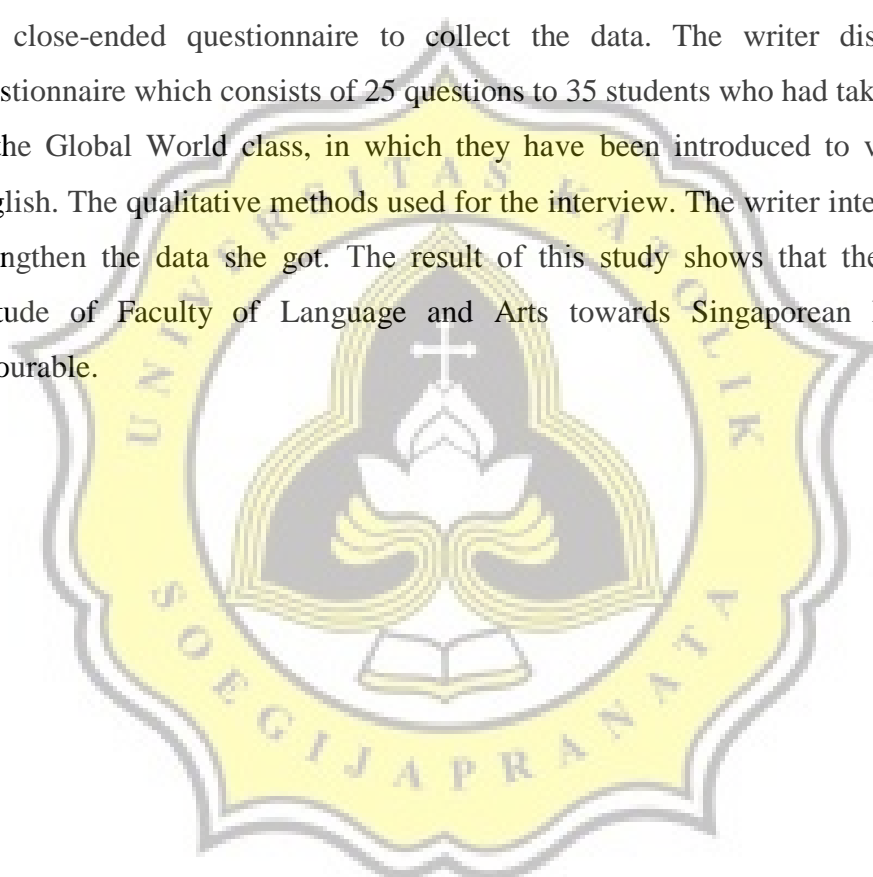
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ABSTRACT

One of the varieties of English is Singaporean which has a different style. This study aims to find out the Students' attitudes of Faculty of Language and Arts, Soegijapranata Catholic University towards varieties of English especially Singaporean English. In this research, the writer used mixed methods, quantitative and qualitative. The quantitative methods used for questionnaires, the writer, used the close-ended questionnaire to collect the data.
