

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the discussion in the previous chapter, the writer concluded that the results of the questionnaires show how the students' attitudes towards Singaporeans' English which is connected to the English in the Global World class. The data show that most of the students are interested in English, not only in British and American but also other varieties of English, especially Singaporean English (statement number six) and they enjoy learning it in the English in the Global World class (statement number eight). They have a desire to learn the varieties of English even though it is not a strong desire and they have favourable attitudes to learn the varieties of English because they think it can help for their future job or career. 85.7% of the participants have positive attitudes in learning Singaporean English, they disagree that learning Singaporean English is a waste of time. Out of the total 25 variables, 72% (18 variables) are responded positively by the respondents while the rest 38% (7 variables) are responded negatively.

5.2 Suggestions

So far the researcher has realized that there are some limitations to this study. Therefore, she would like to suggest that further research in the field of pronunciation, vocabulary in Singaporean English and could discuss it deeper.

Also, the writer hopes that not only Singaporean English that can be used as research materials but also other varieties of English in the global world.
