 - It is a unique version of English language

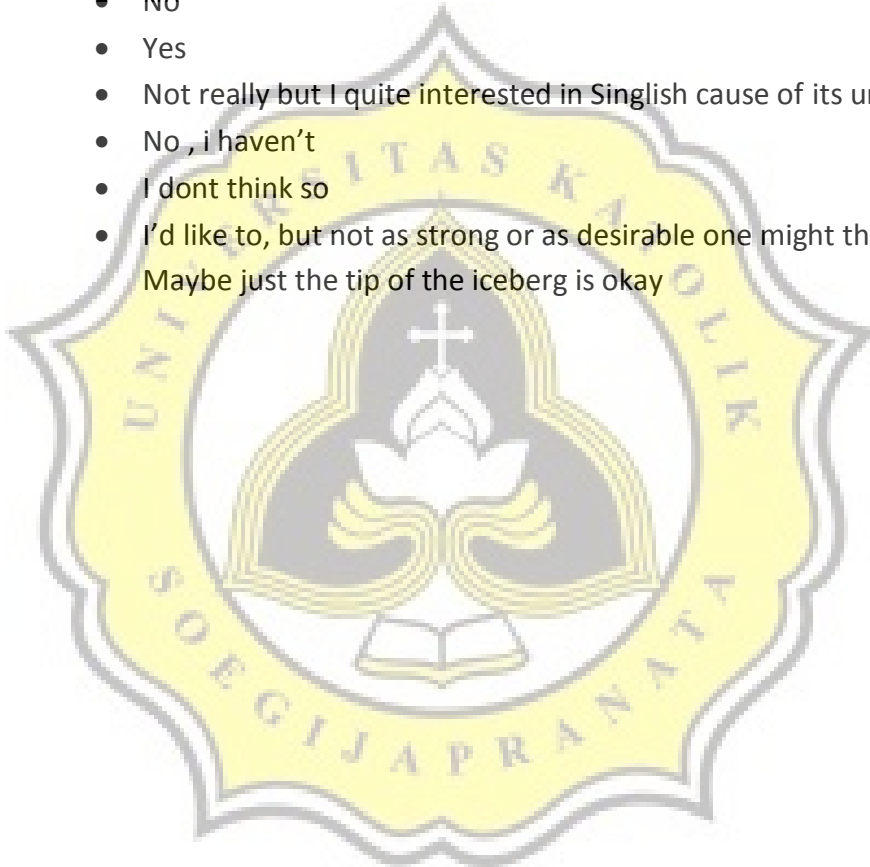
3. Would you get nervous if you had to speak in Singaporean English?

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
