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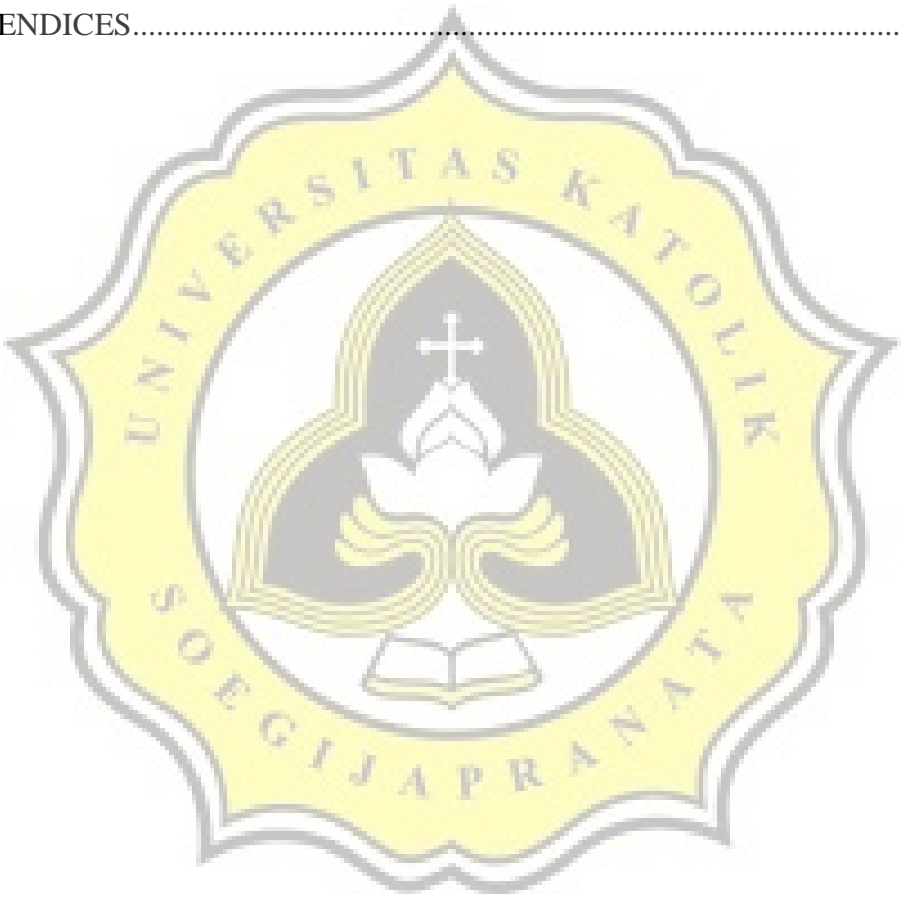
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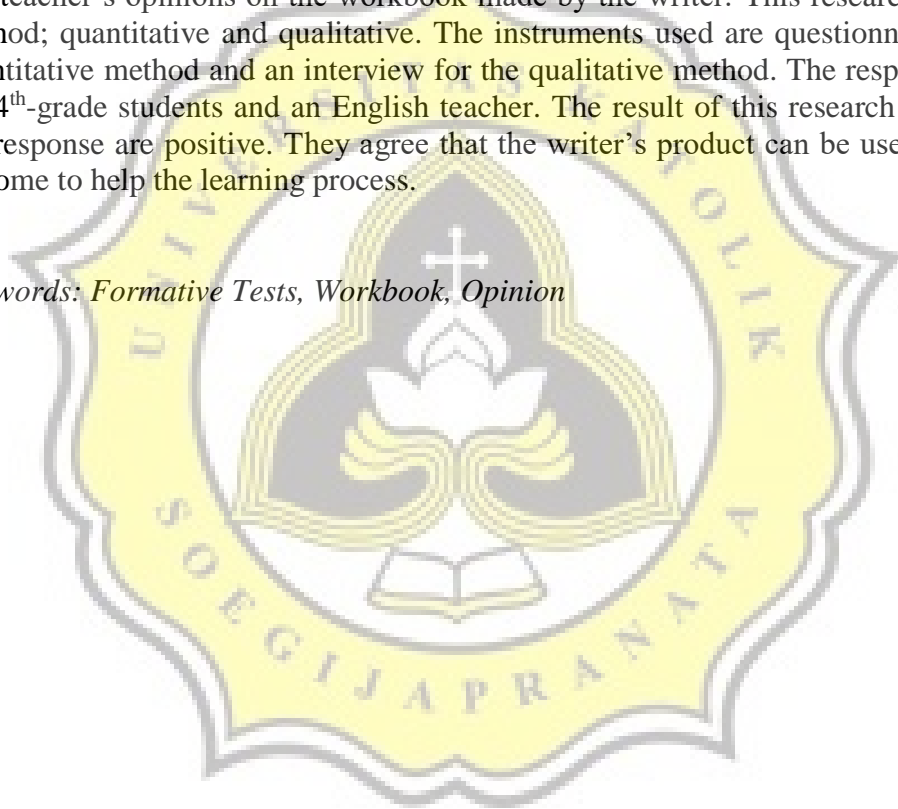
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## ABSTRACT

## ABSTRAK

Di era digital ini, orang-orang dapat dengan mudah menemukan latihan soal di internet saat mereka ingin belajar sendiri. Namun demikian, tidak dapat dipungkiri bahwa mereka masih memerlukan latihan dalam bentuk buku. Guru biasa menggunakan buku latihan untuk mengukur kebutuhan murid. Selain itu, hasil yang dibagikan kembali dan dibahas akan sangat berguna untuk murid untuk mengetahui letak kesalahan dan memperbaikinya. Berdasarkan penelitian yang penulis lakukan terhadap SDI Al-Azhar 14 Semarang, dapat diketahui bahwa sekolah tersebut membutuhkan buku latihan sebagai alat untuk membantu siswa dalam proses belajar mengajar. Karenanya, penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui pendapat guru dan para siswa mengenai produk penulis. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode campuran yaitu dengan menggabungkan metode kuantitatif dan kualitatif. Instrumen yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini berupa kuesioner untuk metode kuantitatif dan wawancara untuk metode kualitatif.
