Review:

The article's main argument is that the violence in Ambon was transformed into successful reconciliation due to the vital role and tireless efforts of the BBM. This argument is based on a background argument that the government failed in overcoming or addressing violent conflict in the region. While the article proves that the BBM contributed to the peace and reconciliation process in Ambon since the initial violence in 1999, it didn't prove its central role, nor put this contribution into the context of other contributions.

The review argues that the role and contributions of state / government, either central (Jakarta), provincial (Maluku), or municipal (Ambon), in peacebuilding and reconciliation,

as assigned by the authors - is misleading and even seriously erroneous. We quote from the relevant review:

"The government effort has paved the way toward Christian-Muslim reintegration. The government's role was not only limited to the initiation of the signing of the Malino Peace pact between the conflicting parties, but also in other informal / formal attempts in establishing peace since the first violence broke out.

It is true there was disagreement within Christians or Muslims about this peace accord, but the agreement had been the most major and momentous stage in attempts at interreligious compromise and cessation of hostilities. The pact led to the gradual diminish of the military presence in Ambon as well as the disarmament of militia groups, creating an opportunity for representatives of civil society associations and religious leaders (including those active in the BBM) to continue or initiate efforts at reconciliation and reconstruction. Without the government initiatives, militia groups (especially non-Ambon Muslim / Islamist militia groupings) were unwilling to lay down their arms and continued to engage in communal violence".

The review suggests that you will relate to the roles and contributions of several high-rank government officials in the peace process, including Jusuf Kalla (at the time Coordinating Minister of People's Welfare), M. Saleh Latuconsina (former Maluku governor), Karel Albert Ralahalu (former Maluku governor), Sinyo Sarundajang (acting governor of Maluku from 2002-03), or Marcus Jopie Papilaja (former Ambon mayor). The article, hence, somewhat glorifies the roles of BBM and diminish the roles and contributions of government. As well, it undervalues productive contributions of other civil society groupings (e.g. the Wayame te, and relate am of Peace).

Thus, you are requested to argue your position and prove it, based on the literature, relating to the work of John Goss or Sumanto Al Qurtuby on these particular topics:

1. Either that BBM was (only?) one force among many, and then lay out the relations among the efforts of the government and other peacebuilding actors and groupings outside the BBM. or
2. Prove their current position that the role of the BBM was paramount and justify the

In such a revised version, please also discuss on Ambon's Muslim-Muslim conflict and Christian-Christian conflict since the fighting was not only between radical factions of Christian and of Muslim.

Our second concern is with the very detailed seemingly unique cultural history and dynamics wich isn't compatible with your argument for the general applicability of the community-and culture based intervention for other conflicts.

As our journal is internationally oriented, the article should contain a comparative scope, or at least generalizable theoretical principles - supported by facts and literature.

The two concern coincide in the importance of arguing if, and to what extent, such community-based intervention requires political preconditions, based on actions by the government as well as cooperation with other grass-root community-based efforts.
