CHAPTER 1 INTRODUCTION Background of the Study Fantastic Beast and Where to Find Them: The Original Screenplay is one of the books written by J.K. Rowling. This book is J.K. Rowling's first screenplay that was designed by Mina Lima. ² The cover and illustrations in this book were based on creatures in the story and inspired by 1920s decorative style (Rowling, 2001).
