#### **ABSTRAK**

Hubungan pacaran maupun perkawinan beda budaya masih menemui kendala dalam penyesuaian diri, khususnya pada pasangan wanita Jawa di Semarang dengan pria Barat. Subjek pada penelitian ini adalah empat orang wanita Jawa yang tinggal di Semarang dengan rentang usia 18 sampai 40 tahun yang mempunyai hubungan yang berkomitmen dengan pria Barat selama paling tidak satu tahun. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui dinamika penyesuaian diri wanita Jawa dalam sebuah hubungan komitmen bersama dengan pria Barat. Peneliti menggunakan aspek penyesuaian diri efektif yang dikemukakan oleh Harber dan Runyon (1984), dan faktor penyesuaian diri terhadap sebuah hubungan berkomitmen yang dikemukakan oleh Hurlock (2008). Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian kualitatif fenomenologis. Hasil dari penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa dinamika penyesuaian diri wanita Jawa banyak dipengaruhi oleh faktor perbedaan budaya dan nilai-nilai yang menimbulkan konflik-konflik internal, seperti stress akibat akulturasi, maupun eksternal. Ketidak efektifan proses penyesuaian diri tersebut kemudian mendorong subjek untuk keluar dari konflik dengan berbagai cara penyelesaian masalah hingga menghasilkan sebuah kemajuan dalam hubungan maupun perilaku yang lebih dapat diterima.

#### **ABSTRACT**

Intercultural dating relationships and marriages still encounter obstacles in term of self-adjustment, especially for Javanese woman who is in a committed relationship with a Western man. The subjects in this research are four Javanese women in Semarang aged 18 to 40 years old who are in a relationship with Western men for at least one year. This study aims to determine the dynamics of self-adjustment of a Javanese woman who is in a committed relationship with a Western man. The researcher used the effective self-adjustment aspects stated by Harber and Runyon (1984) and the factors of self-adjustment to a committed relationship by Hurlock (2008). This research is a phenomenological qualitative research. The results of this research indicate that the dynamics of Javanese women's self-adjusment to a committed relationship with Western men are largely influenced by the factors of cultural and value differences that cause internal conflicts, such as acculturative stress, and external conflicts. The ineffectiveness of self-adjustent process then encourages the subjects to get out of the conflcts with various ways of problem solving to lead into improvement in relationship and more acceptable behaviour.
