

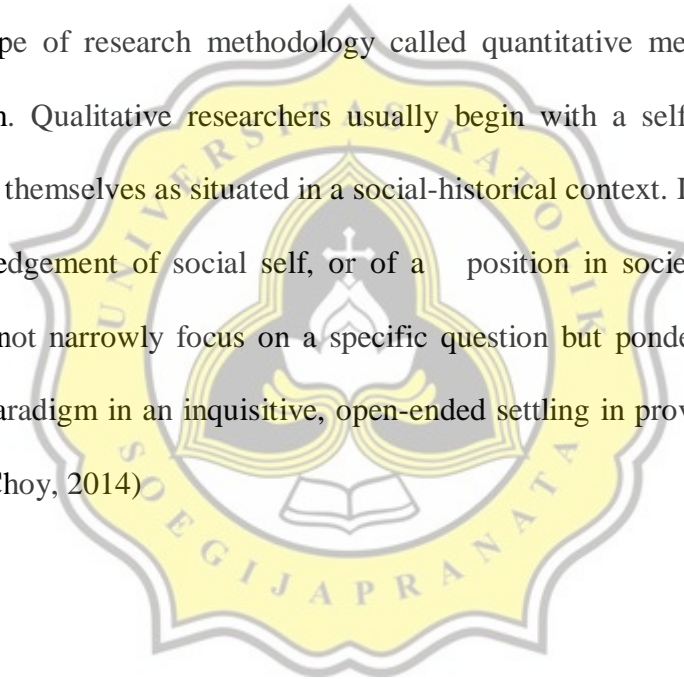
CHAPTER 3
