

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

In order to answer the problem studied in this study regarding the perception of Indonesian bloggers on the significance of using English on blog, in this chapter the writer will describe the perceptions of the respondents in general by drawing a common thread that connects the correlation between the indicators of the questionnaire which then supported by the data from the interview. This chapter discusses two points about the results of the study, the first is the conclusion of the study and the second is the writer's suggestion to the readers of this study based on the result of the analysis and interpretation carried out in the previous chapter.

5.1 CONCLUSION

Based on data from quantitative research, it can be concluded that in general, most Indonesian bloggers consider English to have a significant impact of using English on blog, both in the context of social communication and the context of blog development because the functions of blogs and English are complementary. However, after a more in-depth study and observations, it was found that most of the group members tend to use English only as a support to earn higher income and do not really care about the essence of the English language itself. As the conclusion of this study, most members of Blogger Indonesia community group consider that the use of English on blog has a significant impact, especially in the context of blog development/income.

5.2 SUGGESTIONS

Based on this study's results, there are some suggestions that can be used as advices and considerations for the readers, namely:

1. For future researchers who are interested in similar research, it is recommended to choose respondents who come from different countries outside Indonesia as research objects so that their perceptions on the significance of English can be compared.
2. To get detailed and in-depth research results, it is recommended to use questionnaires and interview items that can explore in-depth information. In addition, the research results are expected to be explained in detail in order to be able to answer the research problems thoroughly.
3. Demographic data is recommended to be included in research data so that it can be used as complementary picture of the percentage of respondents' information distribution.
