**CHAPTER 3** 

METHOD OF DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS

This chapter consists of the process of analyzing the subject and the steps for

attaining the answer to the thesis as follows.

3.1 Research Design

This research used a qualitative method as its approach to gathering its data.

The qualitative method involves the collection, analysis, and interpretation of data

(Creswell, 2009). This paper aims at figuring out the role of color for narrative

purposes in the film *Blue is the Warmest Colour* by using Patti Bellantoni's theory on

color in the film as its based theory.

3.2 Method of Data Collection

3.2.1 Source

This research used the following film as the main source of its data:

The film tells the story of a girl named Adèle and her journey to finding her sexual identity. The story itself spans from Adèle's time as a high school student as she is finding her identity in her adult life where she works as a preschool teacher. This span of time also includes her relationship with Emma.

In high school, as many people of her age do, she is still looking for her true identity. Upon her first encounter with the lesbian community, she meets a woman with blue hair who becomes her first partner as a lesbian. Years go by and her relationship with Emma continues, Adèle has now finished her high school education and become a preschool teacher while Emma has also finished her art study and become a painter. This, however, is when things take a turn for the worse as Adèle and Emma grow distant because of the occupation of their works, feeling lonely, Adèle begins to see other people who are her male workmate. ## 3.2.2 Procedure

This thesis mainly aimed at finding out the role of color in the film *Blue is the Warmest Colour* by conducting a close reading film and intrinsic analysis.

## 3.3 Method of Data Analysis

Making use of the qualitative method, the writer proposed some steps to analyze the film. Firstly, the writer identified the key scenes from five different stages of the story (exposition, rising action, climax, falling action, and resolution). Secondly, the writer analyzed the intention behind the use of color using Bellantoni (2005)'s theory of color in cinema. In this stage, the method used to analyze the intention is through the interpretation of some important scenes based on the use of color in them. Furthermore, the way to come up with the answers is by interpreting the meaning behind the use of a particular color in a particular scene combined with the context of the scene itself. Finally, the writer concluded with the finding of the analysis.
