CHAPTER 3

METHOD OF DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS

3.1 Research Design

The method utilized in this study was a qualitative study. A qualitative study is an inquiry process of understanding based on distinct methodological traditions of inquiry that explore a social or human problem (Creswell, 2009, p. 41).

3.2 Method of Data Collection
