

Saran dari penelitian ini adalah bahwa mahasiswa yang memiliki tingkat pengalaman trauma masa anak dalam tingkat sedang atau tinggi serta berpotensi menunjukkan kreativitas jahat pada tingkatan yang sama disarankan untuk berkonsultasi dengan psikolog guna mendapat pendampingan lebih lanjut. Saran bagi peneliti selanjutnya adalah menambahkan kontrol pada kriteria subjek, mengombinasikan metode *self-report* dengan wawancara, serta menyertakan respon subjek yang berkaitan dengan variabel-variabel dalam proses pengumpulan data. Peneliti selanjutnya juga dapat menambahkan data demografi yang menunjang, seperti asal universitas dan fakultas subjek yang diteliti.

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
