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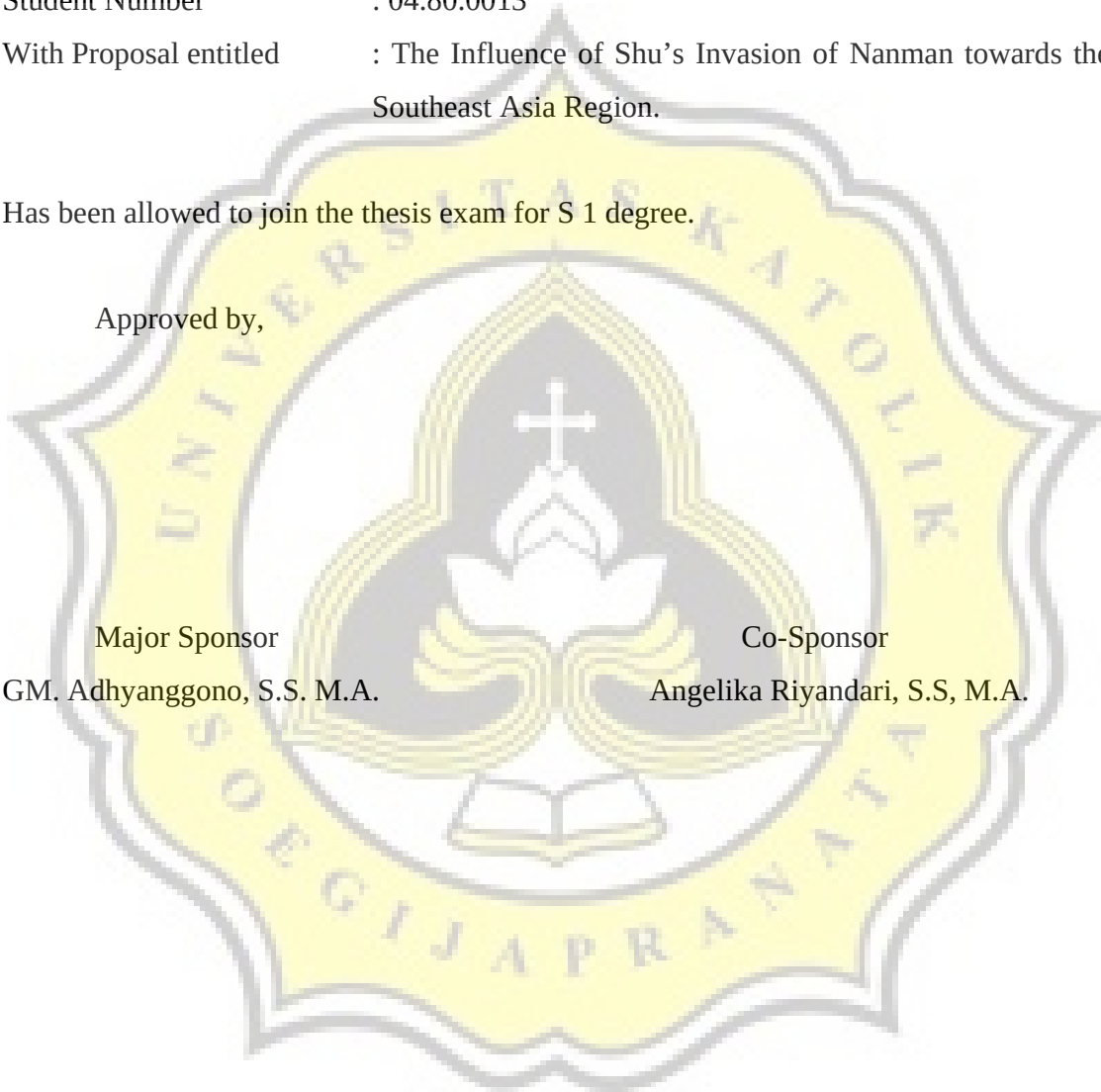
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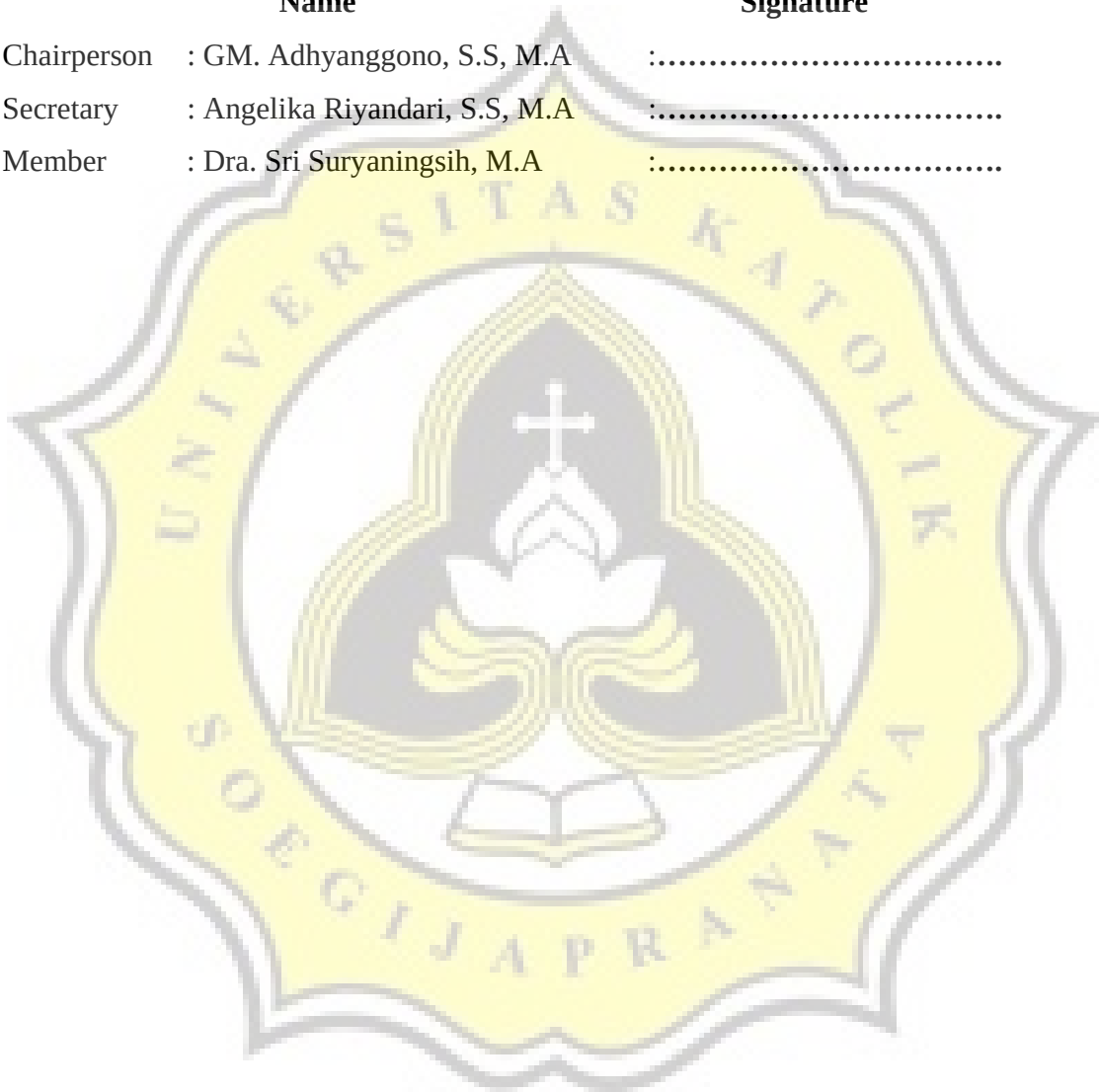


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Abstract

Abstract

Paper ini bertujuan untuk mempelajari penyerbuan bangsa Cina yg dilakukan terhadap bangsa Nanman yang mungkin mempunyai efek tertentu terhadap bagaimana cara bangsa Cina memandang dunia dan bagaimana cara pandang bangsa Cina tersebar ke seluruh dunia. Paper ini juga bertujuan untuk menunjukkan bagaimana cara ideologi, cara pikir, dan filosofi bangsa Cina tersebar di dunia.

Melalui 3 kesepakatan, Zhuge Liang memperoleh Nanman dan memberikan otonomi daerah kepada pemerintahan Nanman, kecuali dalam urusan hubungan luar negeri. Hasil yg diperoleh adalah masuknya tatanan sosial, pengaruh ideologi, dan juga pemahaman letak kekuasaan bangsa Cina yang terletak pada Shu.

Penulis berniat untuk menganalisa paper ini menggunakan pendekatan sosial-historis.
