The paper is well written and the issue is in trend. Nevertheless it seems to focus mainly on a fact finding and a statistical test which eventually could not bring about the concise conclusion. For example, Table 5 and its explanation are hard to understand.

The objectives of this study are unclear. It seems to be a further study from the previous work and the author did not mention how different they are. Did the author use the same methodology and find some new results in this paper or the new analytical approach

was proposed? In addition, a research question like "How is the graphical representation of this correlation?" seems to be a result or conclusion than a normal research question that we want to answer.

The authors would like to investigate the relations among variables affecting the intention to use online gaming. The authors applied statistical techniques such as t-test for difference of means, Pearson's correlation coefficient, principal component analysis and factor analysis to estimate the relationship. However, it is not clear in the paper how did they do that. It seems that the authors might confuse between factor analysis and principal component analysis. Some of the variables such as fe1, fe2, fe3 or pe1, pe2, pe3 are not identified properly so that it is difficult to interpret the results shown in their

tables.
